

careful to select only proven natural materials—stone, wood, real plaster—because they know precisely how such substances will perform in years to come. While there have been striking developments in the production of synthetic materials, the architects refuse to test unproven building elements on their clients' dreams for the sake of saving a few dollars or being on the cutting edge.

The principals and project architects concentrate on oft-overlooked aspects of the design and building process and place great emphasis on authentic detailing. They believe that when a client comes to them with a style in mind, it is usually the style's feeling to which they are attracted rather than the style itself. Several years ago, a client brought in a dozen large boxes filled to the rim with magazine clippings and images of everything from the Taj Mahal to the White House, and Tom and Maurice were able to identify the common denominator and translate that deeper spirit into a thoughtful work of architecture.

Small enough to offer a high level of partner involvement yet skilled enough to take on some rather daunting tasks, Taylor Lombardo Architects has a solid reputation that has brought about a number of exciting projects. Developers in Shanghai, China, sought the California-based firm's expertise in designing nine completely unique, high-end homes for arguably the



most exclusive neighborhood of the city. In a place where space is a luxury, 5,000- and even 9,000-square-foot residences grace quarter-acre lots, and the Taylor Lombardo team gained not only satisfaction from the job well done but valuable experience with long-distance project management and designing for a new clientele.

In addition, the firm has provided resort-planning services for ski villages and golf courses, and the architects draw on those experiences to give their residential work a unique flair. Wineries comprise nearly a third of Taylor Lombardo's portfolio. From working closely with the winemakers to engineer the actual process of winemaking, to designing cellars and tasting rooms, such projects invite creative and project-management challenges but are well enjoyed by the architects.


